The EU Digital Identity Wallet project



The Digital Wallet contract that was awarded to Scytáles together with Netcompany-Intrasoft in December 2022 has been a massive focus for the company in 2023. The European Commission tasked Scytáles with developing a secure European digital identity system, collaborating with the Commission to produce a 'wallet' that will help EU citizens interact with digital services across its 27 member states. It is a project of monumental importance that will transform the lives of European citizens. It will allow them to prove their identity online with greater security and privacy, and to take control of the distribution of their personal information.

We at Scytáles are proud to have successfully delivered all milestones on our part and look forward to all the great work that will be seen in 2024 by all stakeholders. In anticipation of the publication of the Reference Implementation there is ongoing work. The technical standards are discussed by the eIDAS expert group, which consists of representatives of every member state. The expert group defines the Architecture Reference Framework (ARF), which provides a set of specifications needed to develop an interoperable EUDI Wallet instance based on common standards and practices. Based on the ARF a reference implementation is developed, which enables testing within the four Large Scale Pilots.

EU Council proposes launch of mobile driving licences for digital wallets



The proposals would give mDLs full equivalence with physical driving licences, and give the bearer full choice of which to present. Member states would be expected to make mDLs the only default form of licence within 5 years of adopting the implementing acts, with optional issuance before that. Once they reach that point, states will be obligated to recognize the mDLs of other member states.
